Dear Parents and Carers,

We have come to the end of yet another busy half term. A big well done must be given to our wonderful Y6s who completed their SATs. Huge congratulations must also go to our boy's football team who have made it to the Gedling Primary Schools Team Final after winning 3-1 in the semi-final this week- well done boys!
