Dear Parents/Carers

As we are now working on becoming an Eco-Friendly school and as part of this, we have organised for an Eco/Art day on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February. This will include a visit from a local artist showcasing her sculptures made out of recycled materials and then the children will be developing their own sculptures based on the work of a range of artists. Each year group will need to collect different materials for their sculptures; therefore, we would be grateful if you could send in any of the following objects into the children's classes:

F2 – cardboard, bottles

KS1 – cardboard/plastic cups, bottle tops, long sticks or dowel

Year 3/4 – circular objects like old CD/DVD's, bottle tops, jar lids

Year 5 - boxes, bottles, paper, card (anything out the recycle bin) and any unwanted art supplies from home.

Year 6 – newspaper, sticks or dowel, buttons, cardboard/plastic cups

The artist will then be working with a selection of children from across the school to develop a large sculpture to display in our Eco garden. Therefore, we would also appreciate any of the following resources to create the sculpture:

2x adult sized bicycle wheels with tyres removed

2x child sized bicycle wheels with tyres removed

Ribbons, colourful wires, plastic bags, bottle lids, jar lids, CD's

Please could these items go to Mrs Guyler/Mrs Wragg's class in KS1.
