Dear Parents/Carers,

This spring, we are looking forward to celebrating British Science Week (w/c 11th March 2019) with a week of focussed learning on the theme "Journeys", with children and staff participating in fun, exciting and memorable ways to interact with science.

In preparation for this week, we are challenging all children in FS, KS1 and KS2 (and those helping at home too) to participate in a task related to "Journeys" to enter into the school's science exhibition, which will take place during British Science Week. We have listed some suggestions below to help inspire you but would like to leave it up to your child to use their interests and enthusiasm to choose **any particular scientific Journeys** they would like to investigate.

Possible investigations include:

- The impact of friction on journeys.
- The journey of electricity through circuits.
- Journey into/and around space.
- The journey of change through life cycles.
- The journey of food through the digestive system.
- The water cycle journey.



We would like your child to present their findings in the best way they see fit, either as a report, video, poster, artwork model or any other medium that interests them the most. Their work needs to be clearly understood by others and represent a science investigation format so we would request that it: has a title, shows what they have done, what they have found out and the results they have gained in whatever way they choose to present their information.

We would like the children's work to be returned to school for the start of British Science week on Monday 11th March - no earlier please as classrooms quickly fill up and space is needed for lessons! Work will be celebrated by class teachers, who will short listed a few from each class, for the children to be able to share their work with the school during the end of week science celebration.

In previous years, we have been overwhelmed by the wide variety of work produced from all our children from FS through to year 6 and we are extremely excited to see your investigations this year. We hope you and your child enjoy working together to discover the joy of science and would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support.
