Safety Zone Trip at The National Watersport Centre

We have been able to organise a visit to this year's 'Safety Zone' event, which will take place at The National Water Sports Centre (Holme Pierrepont). This is an event that provides children with opportunities to learn about safety and the prevention of avoidable accidents in realistic and lifelike settings. Children will meet safety experts such as: Fire Fighters, Road Safety Officers, Police Officers and St John's Ambulance personnel. They will experience mock scenarios and learn how to deal with them in a controlled and supervised environment. The children are taught safety skills through demonstration and use of real equipment in lifelike scenarios, which is difficult to replicate in a classroom setting. Needless to say, this will prove an invaluable and enjoyable learning opportunity for the children.

The trip will take place during the afternoon of Wednesday 18th September. Therefore, children should arrive at school at the normal time. We will have an early lunch in our own classrooms so we request that all children bring a packed lunch. Children should wear their normal school uniform. However, during their early lunch break, we suggest children get changed into a pair of trainers, to make walking around The National Watersports Centre more comfortable. As the trip will be outdoors, irrespective of the weather forecast or the weather on the morning of the trip, every child must take a coat with them.

The cost of the visit is £5.00 per child: It is necessary to ask for substantial contributions if the activity is to take place. If you do not wish your child to attend, they will join with another class for the afternoon. If you would like support with paying for the trip, please contact the school office where the office staff will be happy to confidentially discuss this matter. If we are not contacted, we assume we will receive payment. Please pay and give permission online via 'Eduspot' by Friday 13th September.
