Dear Parents and Carers,

Hello everyone! I hope you are all well. So sorry to send yet another letter but I thought it might be useful to send a few reminders if you are planning to send your child to school next week. We are expecting a far larger number of people on site as of the June 8th, therefore it is really important that we all observe the following.

In order to limit the number of people on site and to therefore avoid unnecessary opportunities to spread the virus, I must request that when bringing your child to school there is only one adult per family unit. Please can I politely remind everyone that you cannot park in the school car parks.

Please adhere to your allocated arrival and pick up times, along with the entrance we have allocated to you. I realise for some this may mean you have to enter school in a different entrance to the one you would normally use, or have a short wait if collecting more than one child, but again we need everyone to abide by this in order to minimise congestion and congregating. *This information can be found on my previous letter to you.*

If you are picking up a child from nursery you will then need to make your way around to your designated pick up entrance when collecting older children in school. You cannot get through the Lime Trees area.

If your child is coming because you are a Key Worker, please remember that as of Monday, children must be dropped off at 8.45am and picked up at 3.30pm only, using Willow Wong entrance we cannot have people on site at other times and Key Worker children can no longer be picked up from the office.

When you arrive at school, please follow the arrows and signs. There will be lots of staff around the school site to help direct you. Be aware, that in certain places there are one-way systems operating, this may mean it takes a little longer to move around the site- sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

Due to the current restrictions, there will be no fruit for the remainder of the Summer term due to the staggered playtimes, it is also not possible for the school tuck shop to be open for any pupils. In light of this, your child is welcome to bring a fruit snack which they can have at morning break.

Milk will be delivered for under 5 year olds only. If your child is over 5 please reinstate your cool milk account directly with them in order for them to receive milk at school.

A few things to remember every day:

- All children (*including those of Key Workers*) to wear school uniform
- If it's sunny – please send your child with a sun hat and apply suntan lotion before they come to school
- Whatever the weather they need to bring a full water bottle
- A piece of fruit for a snack
- Trainers to change into
- Packed lunch if they have one (school meals are available)



- Remember no toys/books or anything else to be bought in from home
- No bikes or scooters to be left on site during the day

I hope you understand the need to ask, but please could we request that your child has a thorough wash (bath/shower) after school every day and a clean change of clothes on for each new day they are in school – thank you.

Your child will continue to have a learning grid sent to them to work on the days they are not in school.

I hope the above has provided you with lots of useful information and reminders. I know there is an awful lot to think about but please try not to overly worry, as I said before there will be lots of us around to help direct and settle the children into school. It will be a big team effort and we are all really looking forward to seeing the children.

As always, I cannot thank you enough for all the support and understanding we have been shown at this time and over the last 10 weeks. It really has been so appreciated.
