Dear Parents/Carers

As your child will be moving into Year 3 in September and will no longer qualify for a Universal Free School Meal you will need to pay for any school lunches taken. School lunches currently cost **£2.35** per day.

Payment for meals will need to be made through our online system Eduspot (teachers2parents) If you haven't already downloaded the App and have a smart phone, please search for 'teachers2parents' on App store or Play store. It's free to download and use.

### **Pupil Premium**

Each year the school receives extra funding from the government to provide additional support and educational experiences for children who are in receipt of certain benefits. This funding is called Pupil Premium and can help ensure all children have access to the same opportunities and activities.

The funding is used in school in a variety of ways. It is used to support additional learning, to support music tuition, help with paying for trips, school dinners and residential visits and to support eligible children to access extra-curricular clubs and equipment.

The school can qualify for Pupil Premium for your child if you receive one of the following:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after the person stops qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

If you believe your child may qualify for this support in school, please contact the school office.

There is an application form available from the school office, either in person or via the above email address, or you can apply online <http://www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/education/school-meals/free-school-meals-and-milk>. Please note that, should your circumstances change and you no longer qualify for receipt of any of the above benefits, pupil premium funding will still continue to be paid to support your child for a further 6 years.
