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Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope you are all well and your children are beginning to get excited about returning to school next week. Everyone here is really looking forward to the children returning and are busy making the necessary preparations. Below is a reminder of the details you will need: -

	Drop off	Pick Up	Entrance
FS2	9am	3.30pm	Padleys Lane
Y1/2	8.50am	3.25pm	Padleys Lane
Y3/4	9am	3.40pm	All Willow Wong
Y5/6	8.45am	3.30pm	All Willow Wong

As in the Autumn term, please do not arrive earlier than your designated time. KS2 children will be asked to line up in their class lines on the playground, can I politely ask that parents do not congregate on the playground at these times and if possible drop off at the gate and wear masks when on the school site. Members of staff will be at each entrance to help direct everyone. KS1 children may be taken to their classroom doors, please only one adult per family and be mindful to keep a social distance when queuing to drop off. Please also be aware that the one-way system around the school site remains in place.

All children are expected back to school now, in full school uniform please. Remember they will need to bring with them a water bottle, a piece of fruit for breaktime (*optional*) and full PE kit. Hot school meals will be available as normal.

Control safety measures

- Hand washing on entry; after play; before and after lunch
- Hand sanitizing on entry and exit of all rooms
- Children will remain in 'bubbles' at all times (as previously FS2, Y1/2, Y3/4, Y5/6)
- Forward facing seating in classrooms and lunchtimes
- Staggered playtimes and lunchtimes
- Fixed seating plan
- Designated staff team



- Children to use own equipment (provided)
- One-way system around the school site

I'm sure there will be a few 'back to school nerves' felt over the next few days, this is to be expected and quite normal. All the staff at school are really looking forward to seeing the children. They will be ready to welcome your children back and will of course offer any reassurance needed. We understand that children are all very different and we will be ready to support those individual needs that may arise. It won't take long for new routines to establish and become normal.
