Population of around 4,000 and is used mainly as a commuter village for Nottingham. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A town that lies 270 miles from the capital city Dodoma. Population approximately 300,000 Dodoma has been the capital city of TZ since 1974. It was moved from Dar Es Salaam to a more central location.

Physical features-

- *River Trent runs through the village.
- *The climate is temperate, warm summers and cool winters.



Bagamoyo, Tanzania, East Africa

Human features-

- * Houses and apartments.
- * There are schools, churches, a hospital, hotels and Mosques.

Physical features-

- *The climate is tropical, the summers have a good deal of rainfall, while the winters have very little.
- *Tanzania is home to **Mount Kilimanjaro**, the tallest mountain in Africa.

Vocabulary		Definition
Human Features		Something man - made or it was made by a human being e.g. buildings, bridges, houses and parks.
Physical Features		Something which is natural - it happens naturally e.g. land, hills, cliffs, valleys, rivers, volcanoes.
Ordnance Survey (OS) map		An ordnance survey (OS) map is a detailed map produced of an area in Great Britain.
Scale Bar		A scale bar is a line or bar divided into parts. It is labeled with its ground length, usually in multiples of map units, such as tens of kilometers
Climate		The weather conditions in an area in general or over a long period.
Land use		Land use is the function of land - what it is used for. Land use varies from area to area.
