Prepositions have three functions; they are words or phrases that describe **place**, **time** or **cause**.
For example:

The book is **on** the table.

Place: 'on' describes where the book is.

It went dark **after** the sun set.

Time: 'after' describes when the sun set.

Harry was late **due to** the traffic.

Cause: 'due to' describes why he was late.

Look at the prepositions in the box below. Sort them into the table based on their purpose: place, time or cause.
