
Elements of our Music Curriculum

Knowledge and Understanding

(Factual)

Musicians develop a knowledge and understanding of:

- The practical and technical nature of music: controlling sound through voice and instruments, understanding the way music is recorded – staff, notation, symbols.
- The theoretical and constructive nature of music: inter related dimensions of music, composing and improvising.
- 3) The expressive nature of music: the genres of music., the performance of music, the ability to debate and discuss music and its impact on the listener.
