Emergency Contact Details

As always please let the office know if you have moved house or changed your contact telephone number/email address.

Absences

Children's attendance is carefully monitored for Safeguarding procedures. If your child is unwell and unable to come into school, please remember to let us know by 8.30am and state your child's symptoms.

You can report absences via any of the below options-Emailing – <u>absence@burtonjoyce.notts.sch.uk</u> Calling school 0115 9312373 and press option 1.

Holidays in term time must always be requested giving at least four weeks' notice where possible. We have a new procedure for requesting holidays. Once Mrs Cook has processed the request, you will be notified via email.

Late arrivals/School Lunches

If your child is going to be late into school/has an appointment, please let us know using our absence email <u>absence@burtonjoyce.notts.sch.uk</u> or by leaving a message on the answerphone. Please also state if they require a school lunch ordering.

Early Collection

We appreciate it isn't always possible to book appointments out of school hours. If you need to collect your child early for an appointment, where possible please let us know in advance

We now have to ask for proof of all appointments, you can bring the letter into the office or send a copy of it via email.

Medicine

Our Trust Policy is that we can only administer medication if they are prescribed 4 times a day. Full details can be found in our Medicine Policy on our website. If your child requires medication. Please complete this form https://forms.office.com/e/cPCzx1pdMw and ensure the medication is dropped at the school office in the packaging with the prescribed label fully attached.
