English

This half term we will begin by exploring poetry which will be inspired by Valerie Bloom. We will be reading and creating a kenning linked to rivers and then developing rhythm to write our own quatrains. We will identify a range of poetic devices to use when writing our own poetry. After this, we will begin an explanation text exploring the features to plan and write about the water cycle.

Science

Our science unit this half term is all about electricity. We will begin the unit by identifying appliances that run on electricity (mains powered and battery powered), construct a simple circuit, use switches within a circuit, before finishing off with learning about conductors and insulators.

Happy New Year! Welcome back we hope you have all had a fabulous Christmas! The children worked incredibly hard last term and we hope they are ready to learn and enjoy new areas of our curriculum during the Spring term.

Our topic for this half term will be a Geography-based topic called 'Why does our river flood in the winter (River Trent)?'

Geography

Throughout this half term we will be exploring the features of a river, the journey of a river from source to mouth, world rivers and what they are used for. We will also be visiting the River Trent and doing a river study on our school visit to Perlethorpe.

Maths

Year 3 and 4 children will continue with their learning on multiplication and division, using methods including column method. They will also be learning about length and perimeter.

Any additional times-table practice at home will also be beneficial for all children.

Computing

Children will be learning about their digital footprint as part of our e-safety lessons. Then they will be using the app 'numbers' to collect and present data into a table and chart.

Art

In Art we will be learning about the Artist Rachel Whiteread. Whiteread's work mainly looks at the use of negative space and she often makes casts of ordinary domestic objects. We will explore her work and make our own sculptures.
