

Fundraising Update – Autumn 2023

We have had a successful fundraising term, so a massive thank you to all who helped with this and for all the donations and support at the various events. In total we have raised **£6,210!!**



With some of this money the PTA have been able to provide school with the funds required to purchase the Jigsaw PSHE resources and for the annual Drumba subscription. Fundraising continues to provide the funds to upgrade the KS1 playground.

Previous year's fundraising helped provide the funds for the KS2 trim trail, which was installed in the Summer. From buying iPads, putting interactive whiteboards in every classroom and refurbishing and restocking the library, to creating the hub and music rooms and paying for Year 6 leavers' gifts and after-SATs party every year, what the PTA does makes a real difference.
