Science



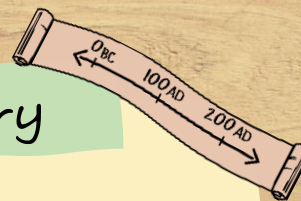
This half term, we continue to explore living things and their habitats. Looking at the different types of habitats, including microhabitats and the food chains within the different habitats to support the survival of living things.

History

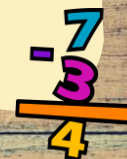


The children will be learning about famous explorers. They will find out what makes them famous, where and what they discovered.

Maths

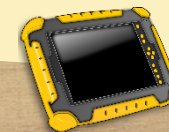
In Year 2 children will be learning their 2, 5 and 10 times-table and relating these to the corresponding division facts.

Computing

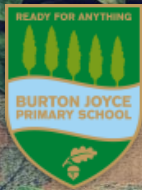
This half term the children will be interviewing each other and filming their interviews. They will learn how to edit the films they make.
