Summer 1 in Year 5/6

English

This half term, we are focusing on writing balanced arguments. This will include learning about the structure and using appropriate language or grammatical features.

Additionally, we are starting our summer term class text called 'Street Child', by Berlie Doherty.



Our focus will be on the topic of 'Animals including Humans'. This will include looking into the main systems which keep our body functioning, a deeper exploration of the human circulatory system, the main parts of the heart, how blood vessels work and what blood consists of.



How is it possible that we find ourselves embarking on the final term of the school year? This will be the final term of our Year 6's primary school lives – let's make sure it's one to remember! Our Year 5 & 6 staffing team really hope you all had a fantastic Easter break and have a full tank of energy ready for the start of the summer term.

Geography

This half term's learning is based on a unit called 'Why do people live near volcanoes and known earthquake zones?' This will include looking into where known volcanic and earthquake zones, what volcanoes and earthquakes are and both the advantages and disadvantages of living in close proximity to known active zones.

Maths

Each lesson will continue to open with a concentrated focus on arithmetic, which helps to develop children's numerical and calculation strategies. For the main body of our lessons, both years 5 & 6 will be studying shape, position and direction.

Computing

We will spend time exploring how to plan, film and create short videos.
Additionally, we will be further consolidating the children's awareness and understanding of the importance of staying safe online and using digital technology to communicate kindly.

Art

In art, much of our work will orientate around the works of Alberto Giacometti, who was one of the most prominent sculptors of the 20th century. The unit of work will culminate in the children producing a sculpture of their own in the style of Giacometti.



PE

To ensure our bodies stay fit and healthy, we will engage in units focusing on the sports of hockey and tennis. In hockey, the children will look to develop their strategic awareness and in tennis they will look to develop their hand-eye coordination whilst developing their forehand and backhand strokes.

Music

Over the next few weeks, our pupils will engage with a unit called 'Exploring identity through song'. This will include aspects of lyric writing and expressive singing to convey mood and emotion.



Our unit for this half term is entitled 'Relationships'. Key aspects of learning are mental health, love and loss, power and

control and using technology responsibly.

The children will delve into a unit called 'Pilgrimages' which involves lessons developing their understanding of what a pilgrimage is, why people from different religions go on pilgrimages to Jerusalem, other Christian pilgrimages and the significance of Hajj for Muslims.
