Shared learning and teaching: Small steps of COMPONENT KNOWLEDGE	
Explain that this half term we will be using the ipads to create a drawing project. Introduce sketches app. Follow step by step instructions using PP as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open sketches school app 2. I do-Model sketching circles using pencil tool 3. Model selecting different thicknesses using circles on the right side of the screen. You do 4. I do- Model using paintbrush again altering thicknesses. You do 5. I do-Experiment adding colour using square bottom right of screen. You do 6. I do -Erase- tap to erase small area, double tap eraser to erase whole page- you do 7. I do-Model using these tools to create an emoji- you do Children will practice using a stylus/finger to create circles using different pen thickness and style	

Then create their own emoji, using pen thickness, fill tool, use different brushes. Allow children to have a good explore, then create their final emoji.
