English

We will be reading 'The Search for the Giant Arctic Jellyfish', with the aim of writing our own Arctic story. Focussing on using full stops and question marks along with noun phrases. We will also be writing a non-chronological report about the weather in the UK.

Science

The children are going to be exploring seasonal changes within the year. The children will learn about the different months within each of the four seasons, along with the weather and hours of sunlight within each season.

Welcome Back

Welcome back to school after the Easter Holidays. We hope you had a wonderful break. Here is an outline of what your child will be learning during this term. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

Geography

The children will be exploring the different continents and oceans and what affects the weather in different parts of the world. They will then compare these weather changes to the weather we have in the UK.

Maths

Year 2 will begin to explore fractions this half term. They will focus on half, guarter, three guarter and a third. Year 1 will be focussing on finding half and quarter of shapes and quantities. They will also be exploring turns and directions using quarter and half.

Computing

During our E-Safety session we will look at how everything we see/read online isn't true. Our unit focus is data, we will collect data and use online software to create a pictogram/bar chart.

Art

Through the study of Paul Klee's work, the children will begin to understand the concept of abstract modern art. They will then create their own work inspired by some of his well-known pieces.





















PE

Children will be focussing on athletics skills this term. They will be developing their running, jumping and throwing techniques. The children will also be developing their catching and hitting skills during tennis sessions.

Music

Children will be listening to pieces of music and interpreting it through dance. They will engage imaginatively with the piece by drawing pictures. Finally, they will compare their interpretations with contrasting animations and videos.



In Jigsaw this half term the children will be looking at different relationships which will include different family units and how to develop healthy friendships.

Spellings

Spellings are sent out weekly; to rehearse the phonics they are learning in school. Please ensure your children practise them regularly to cement their learning and build their confidence.

RE

The children will be learning a range of bible stories based on miracles performed by Jesus. They will then think about the messages these stories are teaching Christians
