Summer 2 in Year 3/

English

In English this half term we will be using the wordless picture book 'Journey' children will explore the story and think about the characters thoughts and emotions throughout the story, they will then use these ideas to create a diary from the point of view of the main character. Later in the half term children will be looking at a selection of poems and identifying their features.

Our topic for this half term will be a History-based topic called 'What happened to the Indus Valley Civilisation?'

Maths

This half term, Year 3 will be finishing off their unit on time, before moving on to shape and statistics.

Sound

The children will learn how sounds are created and how they travel. They will also be finding out about pitch, volume and investigate how sound gets fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.



We will be looking at where and when the Indus civilization was and who the Indus people were. Using artefacts and theories from a range of historians to figure out why the Indus civilization came to an end.

PE

In PE we will be covering cricket (striking and fielding) and outdoor adventurous activities.
